Making a difference in Texas communities

Volunteering is one of the most important ways Entergy employees power life in our communities.

In 2021, employees in Texas dedicated more than 14,300 hours of volunteer service hours valued at approximately \$410.200.

Recent activities included:

- Packaging and distributing food at Southeast Texas Food Bank and Montgomery County Food Bank.
- Supporting homebound senior citizens with Meals On Wheels Montgomery County.
- Free tax preparation to help qualifying customers claim federal Earned Income Tax Credits.

Powering disaster relief in Texas communities

Entergy Texas committed \$650,000 to help community nonprofits and qualifying customers who were struggling with the financial impact of Winter Storm Uri. These grants went directly to local nonprofits that assisted low-income customers with emergency needs following the storm, including the Montgomery County Food Bank, Brazos Valley Food Bank, Southeast Texas Food Bank, and SBP USA. Additional funding also was provided to The Power to Care to help Entergy Texas customers who are lowincome older adults and people with disabilities.
