



## **Important Construction Update Montgomery County Power Station**

As Entergy Texas builds the Montgomery County Power Station, we are taking every step to minimize the impact on our neighbors. Certain construction activities may result in increased truck traffic on Longstreet Rd. However, we are looking to take steps to ensure we are not getting in your way.

Starting this weekend, we will have several large deliveries of concrete as we begin to pour the foundation for the facility. The concrete deliveries will happen on the following dates over the next several weeks. It is important to note that these deliveries may change due to the weather.

### **When are these deliveries?**

Saturday, January 26, 2019  
2:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.  
Approximately 120 total trucks

Tuesday, January 29, 2019  
2:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.  
Approximately 120 total trucks

Thursday, January 31, 2019  
8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.  
Approximately 40 total trucks

### **What is Entergy Texas doing to minimize the impact to the neighborhood?**

We've taken several steps to make this easy on the neighborhood. First, we will attempt to make these deliveries overnight to lessen any impact to traffic. Additionally, we are directing as many as these deliveries to come via Interstate 45. The majority of these deliveries will come down Longstreet Rd. from Interstate 45. However, the amount of concrete needed requires us to source concrete from multiple locations including one that requires the trucks to travel from the west down Longstreet Rd.

We will have additional concrete pours in mid-Feb that will also happen from the 1:00 a.m. – 7:00 a.m. and we will provide additional information on those future pours as the details become available.
