

Shoreline Contractors Directory (2022-2023)

While Entergy has no restrictions upon who performs shoreline work, as long as it complies with the standards specified in the permit agreement, the following is a list, in no particular order, of contractors who have attended a Contractor Workshop for Shoreline Permit Work led by the Entergy Shoreline Management staff. These contractors have demonstrated a general understanding of the permitting requirements for shoreline work and are all licensed contractors with the State of Arkansas for dock construction and/or shoreline stabilization work.

"Facilities" includes: docks, boardwalks, piers, swim decks, etc.

"Bank Stabilization" includes: seawalls, riprap, bioengineering methods, etc.

"Dredging" includes: lakebed excavation, silt/debris removal, etc.

The order of the list is random and does not indicate any sort of preference. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to ensure work is performed as agreed in an approved permit issued by Entergy. Names may be added and removed from the list at any time, without prior notification to the applicant or the contractors.

Note: All electrical work along the shoreline or on a facility shall be in accordance with the current version of the National Fire Protection Association Standards for Marina and Boatyards, the National Electrical Code and all other federal, state and local codes. Entergy recommends that all electrical work be installed and periodically inspected by a licensed electrician.
