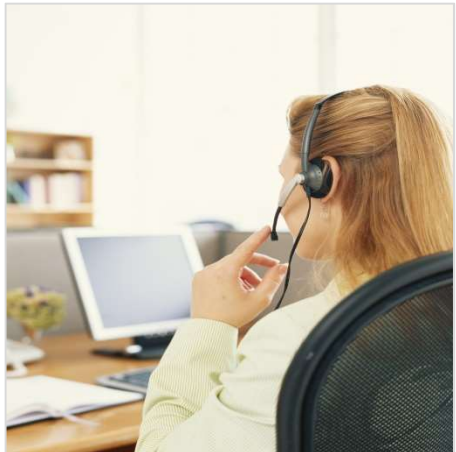
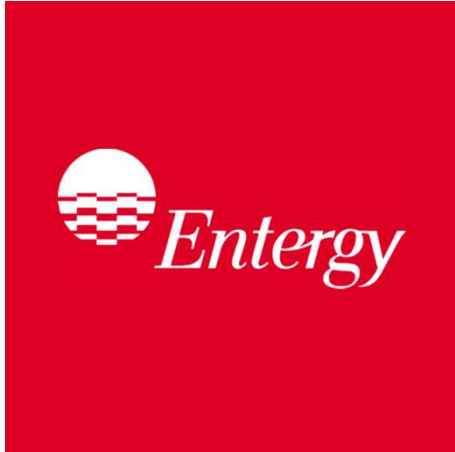

# Why Investment Recovery?

- Profitably help manage the *entire* life cycle of assets
  - Cradle to grave costs money – cradle to cradle makes money
- Over the last five years (2015-2019) Entergy realized over \$65M from the IRS program that was reinvested in the Company
- Benefits include:
  - Cost avoidance
  - Inventory level reduction
  - Improvement of space utilization
  - Strengthening of earnings through reduction of operating costs
  - Tax minimization
  - Landfill avoidance
  - Diverting waste while making money
  - 100% of proceeds on asset sales go back to the asset owner

# Entergy E-Bid

- Great employee motivation and morale booster
- Used for the disposition of obsolete or surplus internal assets such as trailers, boats, four wheelers, furniture, small equipment, etc.
- Bidding process is real time online
- Employees can bid using a link on Entergy's internal SharePoint site, or using their own mobile device to access the external auction site.
- Over the last five years (2015-2019), E-Bid has recovered over \$1M in sales to employees.
