Giving back to our communities through philanthropy, volunteerism and advocacy are integral to our corporate mission.

We invest in solutions that attack the root causes of poverty, support education and workforce development, and protect and preserve the environment. Stepping up to help with bills

Higher than usual temperatures last summer drove record energy use and this, combined with higher natural gas prices, produced higher electric bills. To help ease the burden, Entergy Mississippi worked closely with regulators to launch Operation Bill Assist, a \$3.2 million shareholder-funded effort to help customers manage high bills. The campaign included more than \$1 million in \$150 bill credits for eligible customers, more than \$540,000 in donations to nonprofits that provide emergency bill payment assistance for elderly and disabled customers through The Power to Care and other programs, an education campaign and nearly \$1.1 million in free energy efficiency kits that Entergy Mississippi employees and community partners distributed across the state.

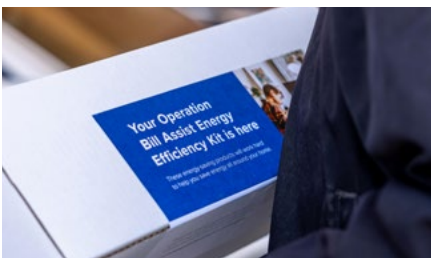
Feeding families
