- Reducing food insecurity with Blue Cross Blue Shield of Louisiana.

Giving back with bill help

The heat last summer led to record-breaking energy usage and higher than normal bills for some customers. To help ease the burden, Entergy Louisiana worked closely with regulators and local agencies on a series of measures that included \$1 million in shareholder contributors for relief across the state. This relief included bill credits for eligible customers and more than \$100,000 to The Power to Care that provides emergency bill payment assistance to older adults and disabled customers. Entergy employees also worked with community partners to help customers beat the heat by providing fans and making homes more energy efficient through weatherization efforts.

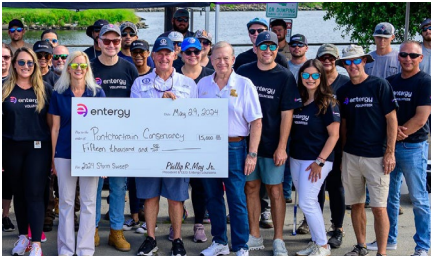
