Giving back to our communities through philanthropy, volunteerism and advocacy is integral to our corporate mission.

We invest in solutions that attack the root causes of poverty, support education and workforce development, and protect and preserve the environment. Our shareholders contribute \$16-\$18 million annually to strengthen the communities we serve. In 2021, they contributed approximately \$1.3 million to nonprofit partners in Mississippi.

Making a difference in Mississippi communities

Volunteering is one of the most important ways Entergy employees power life in our communities.

In 2021, employees in Mississippi dedicated more than 15,173 hours of volunteer service hours valued at approximately \$433,037.

Recent activities included:

- Collecting and distributing more than 1 million bottles of water to neighbors across the tri-state area.
- Free tax preparation to help qualifying customers claim federal Earned Income Tax Credits.
- Helping to feed local families in need for Thanksgiving.

Powering education in Mississippi communities

Entergy Mississippi committed more than \$523,000 to improve educational and workforce development opportunities in our communities in 2021. Grants to Jackson State University, Magnolia Speech School, Mississippi Coding Academies, Mississippi State University and Tougaloo College, among other schools and nonprofits, provided high quality educational programs and advanced the growth of a skilled, engaged workforce. These resources help Mississippians reach their full potential, cultivate a diverse workforce and improve quality of life for everyone in our state.
